

Safety Training in Oil and Gas Can Help Save Lives and Reduce Injuries




In the oil and gas industry, where safety hazards are an everyday reality, substantial safety training plays a crucial role in supporting employee safety and reducing financial losses.

U.S. oil and natural gas industry nonfatal injuries and illness rates, 2011-2021









Fatal occupational injuries in U.S. private-sector oil and gas extraction industries









